Veterinary care shall include routine vaccines and a veterinary approved heartworm and flea/tick prevention. Adopter (2) further agrees that said pet shall reside inside adopter's home and shall not be allowed to roam freely, nor live outdoors or be tethered outside at any time unsupervised.

Adopter (2) hereby agrees to have said pet spayed /neutered within six (6) weeks of signing this contract if said animal is unaltered and deemed old enough and healthy enough by licensed veterinarian. If said animal is too young, adopter (2) hereby agrees to have said animal spayed/neutered by five (5) months of age, or current owner (1) reserves the right to reclaim said pet. Furthermore, adopter (2) agrees to provide current owner (1) with a veterinary statement and/or spay /neuter certificate by 6 months of age of said animal. I hereby agree that this pet shall wear a collar or harness with identification tags at all times.

I, adopter (2) hereby agree that the adoption fee of \$ _225.00_ helps to cover the current owner's expense of caring for the animal and the pet's expenses related to adoption and is not refundable. I hereby understand and agree that the current owner (1) makes no representations or warranties, expressed or implied, about the above mentioned animal's temperament or future health and is hereby absolved from any liability for future damages, injuries caused by said animal, or medical bills for said animal from this day forward.
